Pulp Clamp - There is a wide range of lift truck accessories available in order to make the equipment a lot more effective. A snowplow attachment can be mounted to the front of the forklift. A scoop bucket could be useful whenever the task requires moving sand, gravel, soil or snow. A double block handler allows the forklift operator to pick up a couple of loads and then stack them beside each other. Many of those accessories are considered ideal for light to medium duty work.

Another forklift attachment is the package lift clamp, that could lift and transfer heavier pallets. Furthermore, pallet crane forks may be used so as to carry and transfer pallets with an overhead crane. A drum clamp accessory is helpful for transporting really heavy drums from place to place without having to utilize a pallet. Lift truck mounted hoppers permit material to be moved and dumped with out having to handle it by hand. These hoppers are self dumping when the bumper is released.

Available accessories now include accessories which allow a lift truck to do the job of a commercial mop or broom. Such specific attachments are most frequently used cleaning parking lots, warehouse floors, and boat docks. Lift truck mounted platforms are accessible equipped with twin entry doors and could be hooked up to transport workers from one area to another. The mounted platform accessory is ideal for reaching places which can be hard to access, especially when you've got goods or supplies stored in out of the way places or really up high.

Attachments can be a really helpful piece of equipment when installed onto a lift truck, changing a regular forklift into a mobile crane unit. It is most useful when moving unsteady or tricky loads. This accessory could either be mounted on the carriage itself, telescopic, or be fixed or even lift truck mounted.
