

Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriages - Rated by the tine carriage lifting capacity, there are actually four sizes of hook type fork carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks could differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
